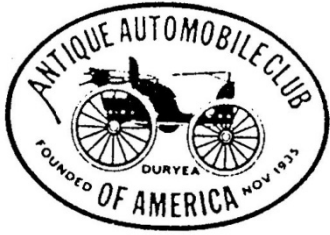

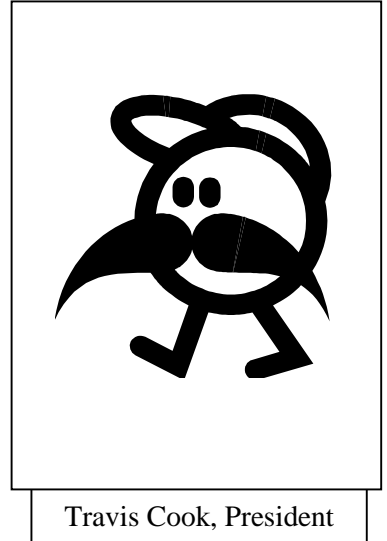
The pizza party will be held on the show field after the clean up is finished. It would be a good idea to bring chairs if you can.

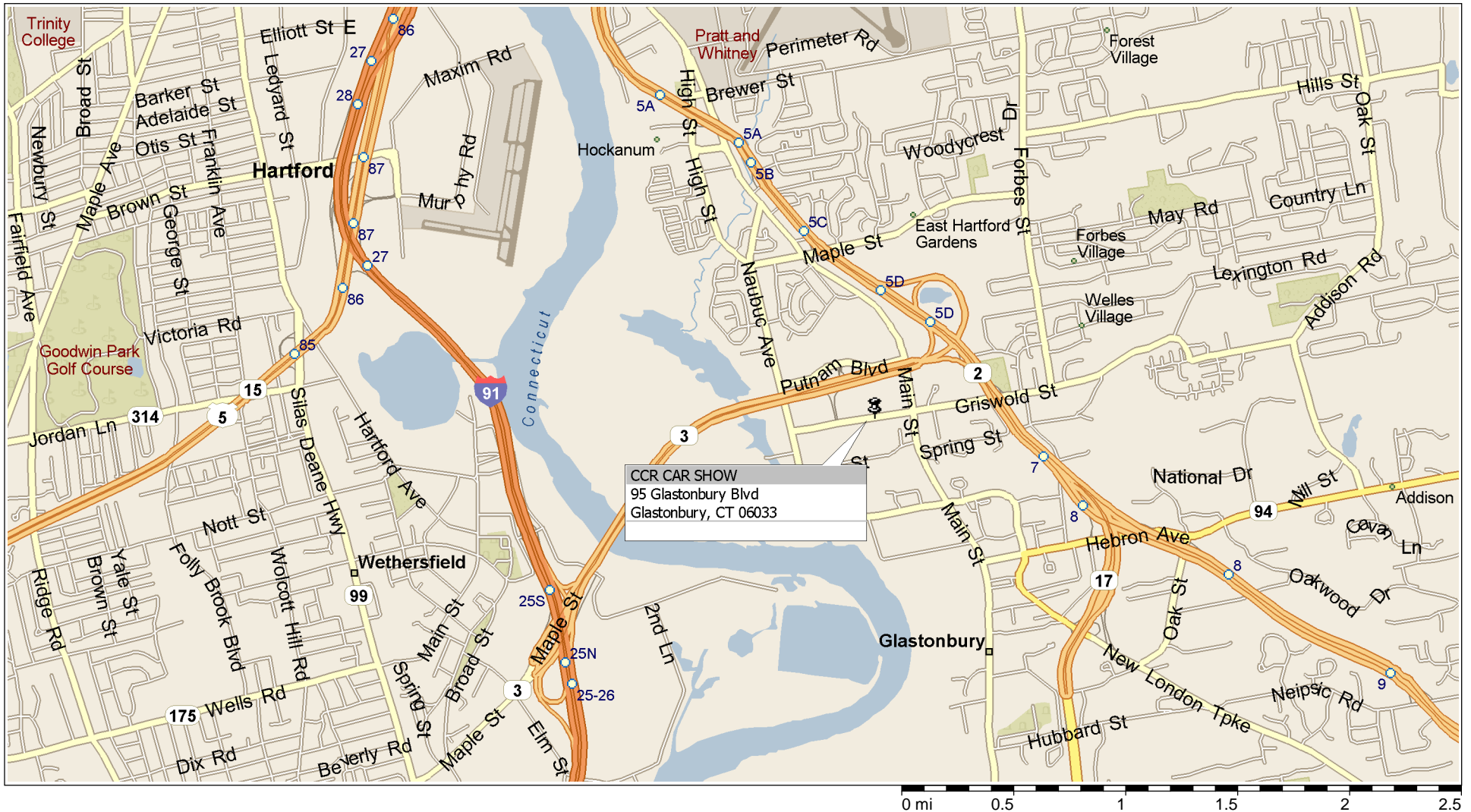

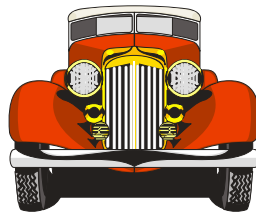
