From the editor....

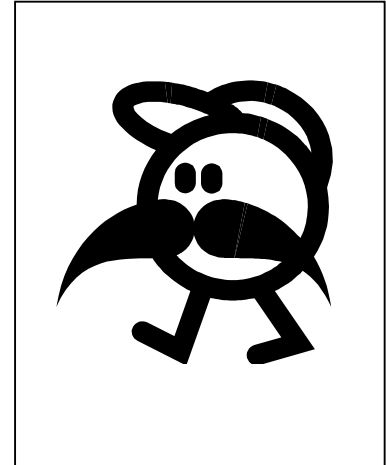

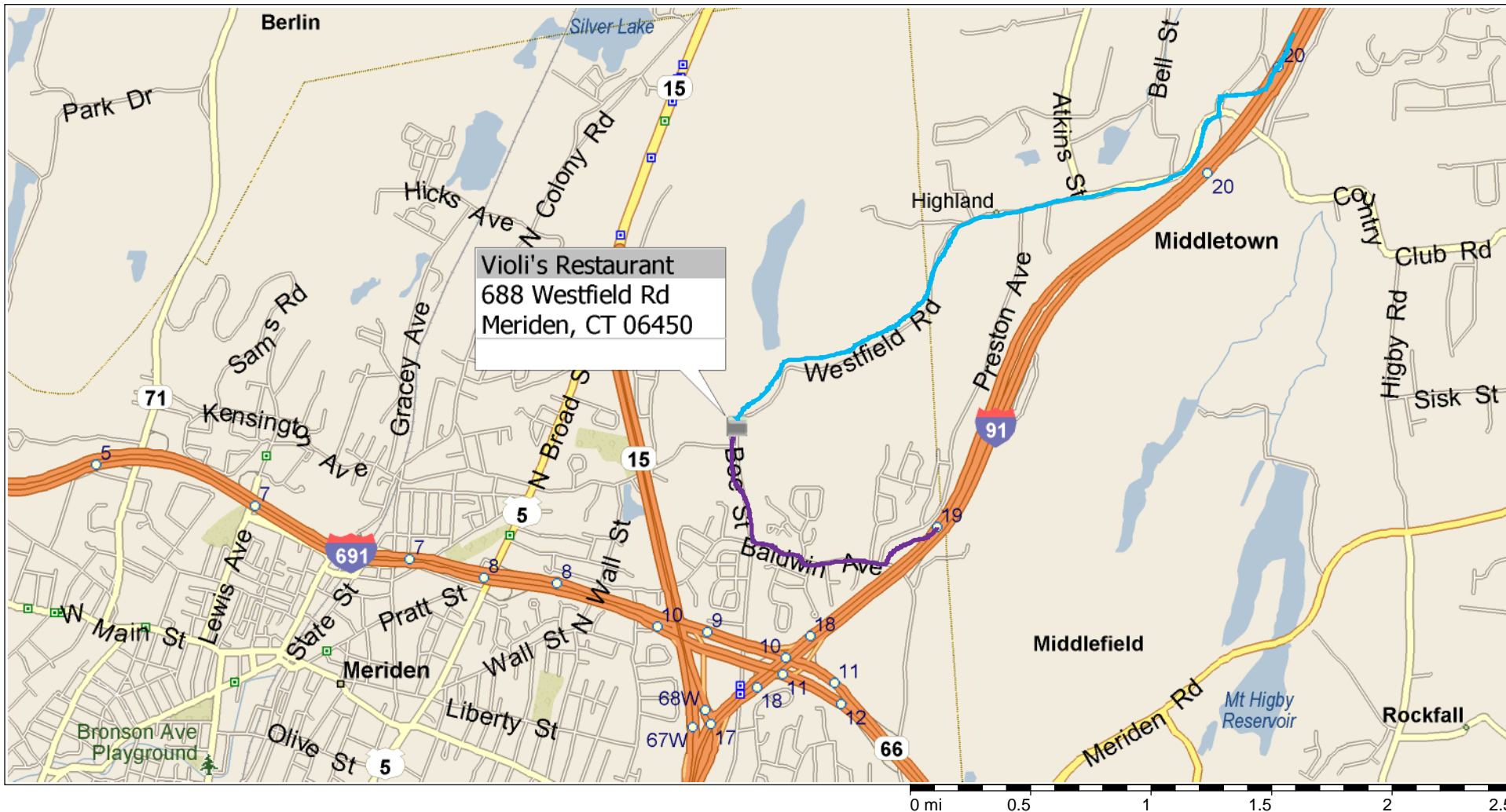

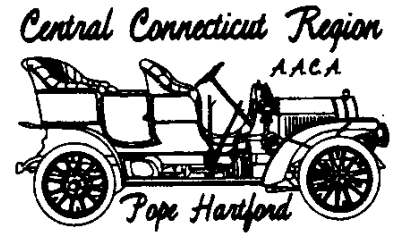
