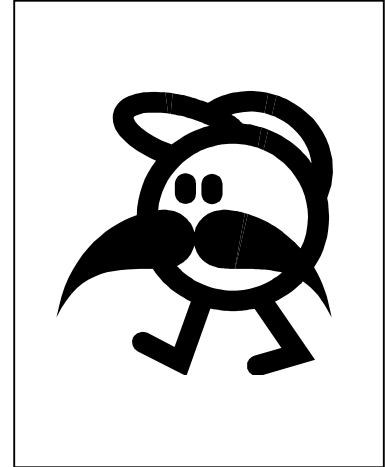
From the editor....

Youth Judging Program

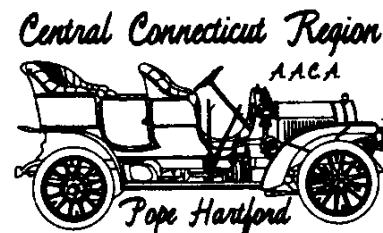
