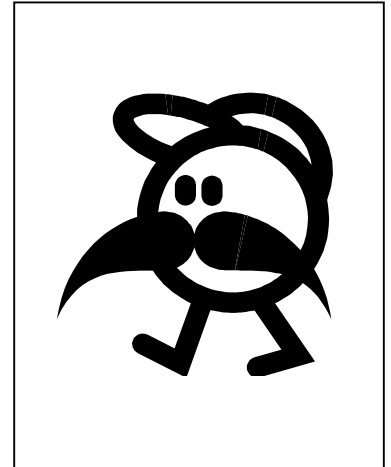
President's Message

July 2016

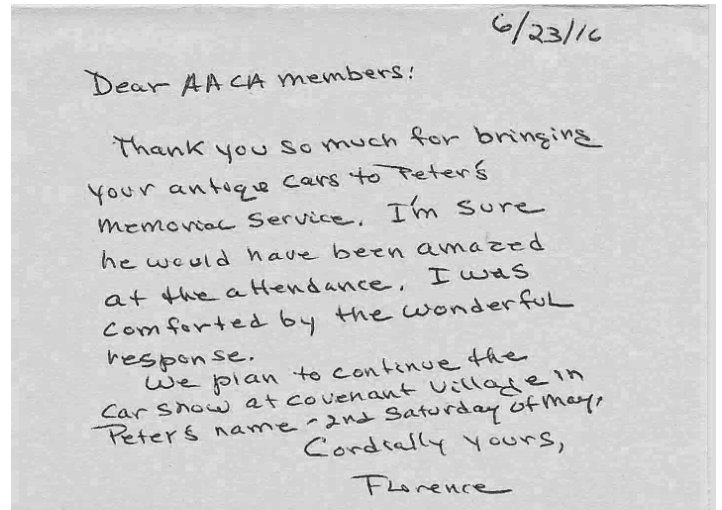

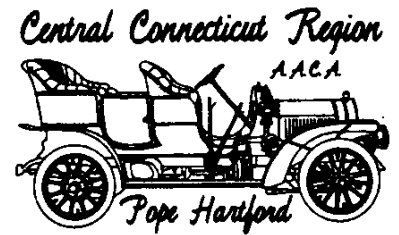
