President's Message**May 2016**

Our show date has been changed from June 12th to September 18th with a rain date of September 25th. These dates have been chosen after quite a bit of discussion and after looking for suitable show sites. The reason for this change is due to a paving issue with one of the parking lots at our original Glastonbury Blvd. site. The paving contractor can't commit to a firm date due to weather changes which he depends on for "good" conditions for paving. So, that being said, we had to make a decision for a new show date and the possible show relocation.

Our new location will be at the Elk's Club at 98 Woodland Street in South Glastonbury. For all or our members, please keep this Distributor close at hand for future reference for dates and directions.

The other major change will be to all of our ad forms to reflect the new date and location. The real plus for ad deadlines is that the due date has been pushed out to August 20th. 

As you have already read in the President's Message, our car show will move to a new date, time and location this year. I'm looking at this as a great opportunity to improve what is already considered an excellent show by our participants. Each year we attract more cars and have outgrown our location on Glastonbury Blvd. The parking is tight and required much attention from parking staff because at least half of our cars have to back into their spots. The construction of the hotel next door resulted in us losing a whole section of the parking lot and their guests continually are parked in our show field. This, and the fact that we are dealing with out-of-state property managers, makes it difficult to start advertising early. The paving in June was a main factor in looking for another location.

Our new location at the Glastonbury Elk's Club will provide at least twice the space, is all on grass, has a great pavilion with plenty of picnic tables and easy parking for show cars, spectators, trailers and the flea market. If this works well this year we will be able to lock in our date every year. Please put September 18th on your calendar and plan to help make this show another success. It will take all of us!


