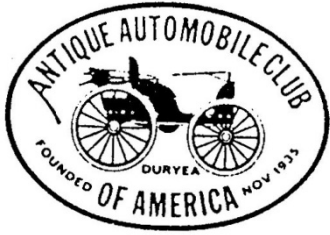

### From the editor....

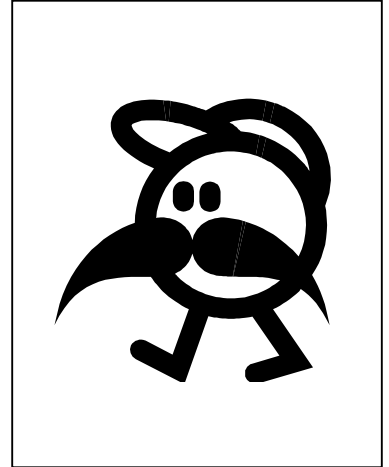

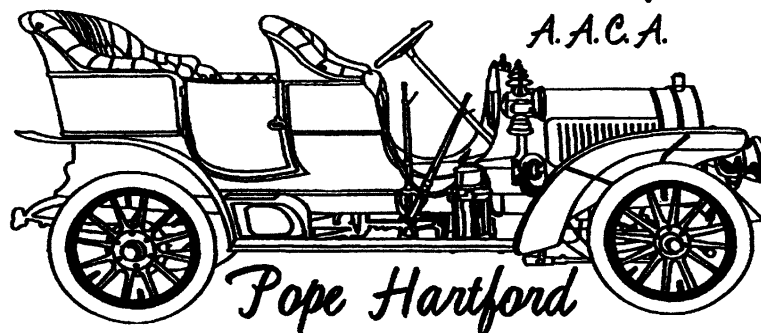
